## **Splinters from the Board Meeting, April 15 2016**

Nancy Devereux Center Fundraiser hosting passed with 29 yes votes, one no and one abstention. A second planning committee meeting has taken place with Tara Johnson, Marian and Asialee Crumley, Thea Wilson and Bittin Foster Duggan. See NDC Update below for outcomes.

Jean introduced the possibility of SCUUF hosting a music concert for the public in the fall. Tom Neilson (The Bard Insurgent; his website is <tomneilsonmusic.com>) is an activist itinerant folk singer who writes and sings songs with a political slant, on a grant from Music Performers Trust Fund. After discussion she agreed to research artist and terms further.

Thea recalled that board member training attended in the past and suggested we seek out an opportunity for current board to go again. It was put on by the Center for non-profit Stewardship. Board agreed to allocate \$300 to travel and training in the budget to help with such an event.
