SCUUF Programs and Activities for June - All programs will be held Sundays at 10:00 am at the Dolphin Theater.

July Theme: Sources of Our Living Tradition

Unitarian Universalism is a religion based on a covenant, not a fixed set of beliefs and yet, we say we "draw on" six sources for our spiritual practices. For the months of July and August, we will explore these sources. The first Sunday of each of these two months will be an introductory talk by Dr. Ruth Miller. Members or friends will then explore an individual source in more depth on subsequent Sundays each month.

July 7. *Dr. Ruth Miller.* "First 3 Sources of Unitarian Universalist Traditions." Unitarian Universalism is built around 7 principles, drawing from 6 spiritual sources. Dr. Ruth Miller will introduce us to 3 of them in this week's talk - prophetic wisdom of men and women; world religions, and the transcendent mystery - sharing their essential similarities and a few of the differences that distinguish them.

July 14. *Leanne Lovie.* Direct experience of that transcending mystery and wonder, affirmed in all cultures, which moves us to a renewal of the spirit and an openness to the forces which create and uphold life.

July 21. *Jessica Lloyd-Rogers.* Words and deeds of prophetic people which challenge us to confront powers and structures of evil with justice, compassion, and the transforming power of love.

July 28. *Speaker TBA.* Wisdom from the world's religions which inspires us in our ethical and spiritual life.

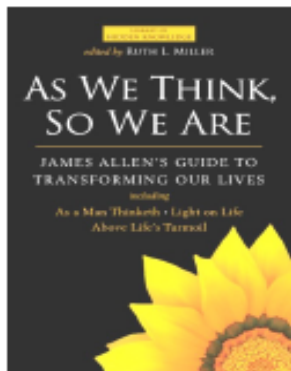
